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### SUGGESTED QUESTIONS

The following questions should help to brainstorm if you don't already have a story in mind.

### REMEMBER:

- Each recording should be about 3-4 minutes
- Pick one particular question or memory to talk about
- In order to stay focused, think about what you'd like to say – and perhaps even outline your response on a piece of paper – before you hit “record”

### Questions about the BTS experience

- What is your favorite story about Bangor Theological Seminary?
- Why did you choose to attend BTS?
- What is your first memory of BTS?
- What do you most remember about your favorite professor(s)?
- What was your most memorable class or assignment?
- What was your most difficult and/or proud moment at BTS?
- What was the most important thing you learned at BTS?
- What are some of the most important lessons you learned in seminary?

### Questions about your ministry or vocation

- How do you define ministry and/or vocation? What are they about?
- Which life experiences and/or interpersonal relationships have shaped your ministry or vocation the most? (Remember: You only have time to talk about one or two.)
- How has your ministry or vocation changed since graduation?
- What post-graduate educational resources and life experiences have proven particularly useful in your ministry or vocation?
- Are there things that get in the way of you being able to minister as well as you would like?
- What would enable you to minister in the most effective way possible?
